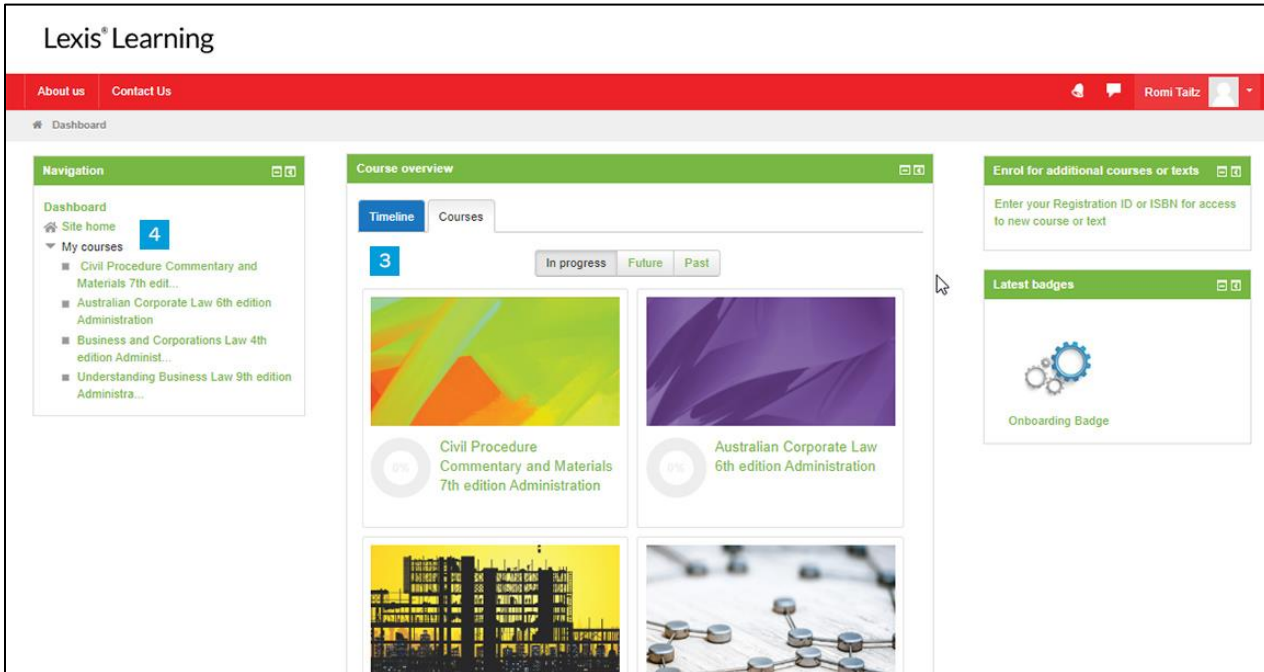

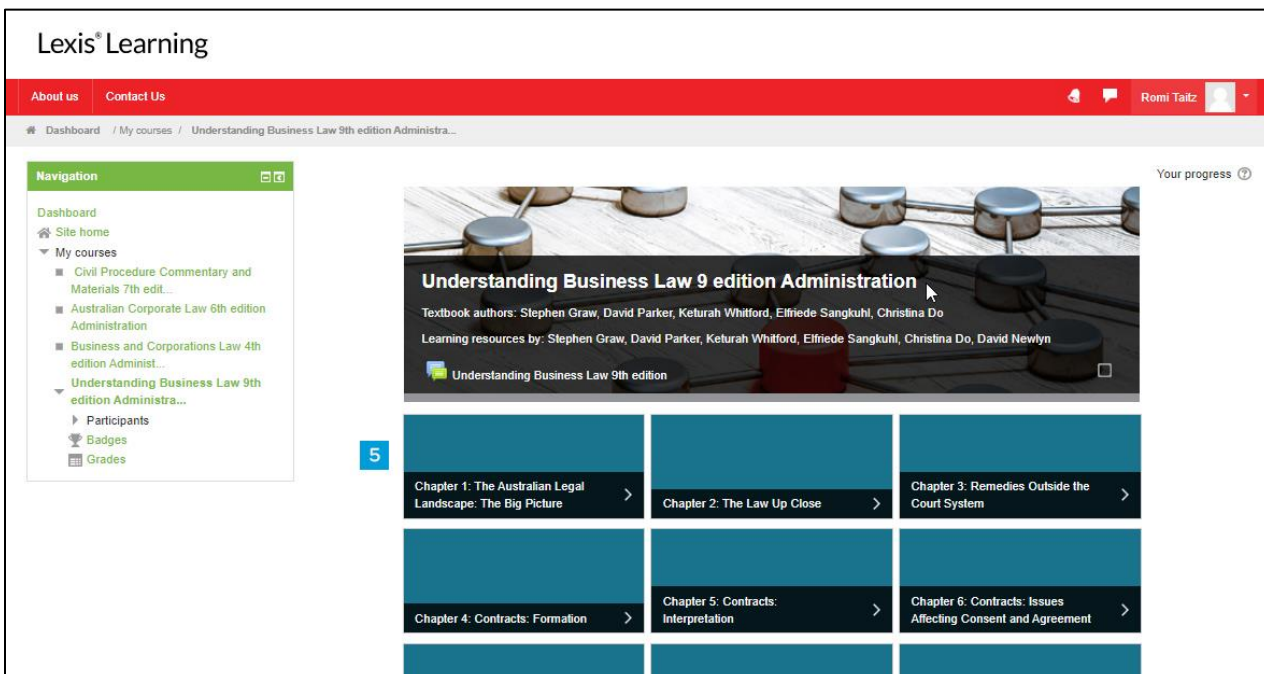

Clicking onto the title of the text will reveal the course page. Select the relevant chapter/section from which you would like to review resources from [5]



The list of available resources will be displayed. Select the resource you wish to view. PDF, Word and Powerpoint presentations will automatically download [6]. Interactive learning activities can be opened and viewed within Lexis®Learning by clicking on the title next to the yellow icon [7]. These interactive activities can also be downloaded and uploaded into your own Learning Management System, to do this, click on the title that says 'downloadable SCORM zip file' [8]. The SCORM file will download to your preferred location. If you cannot find this location, please click on the browser you currently use and refer to their guide.
