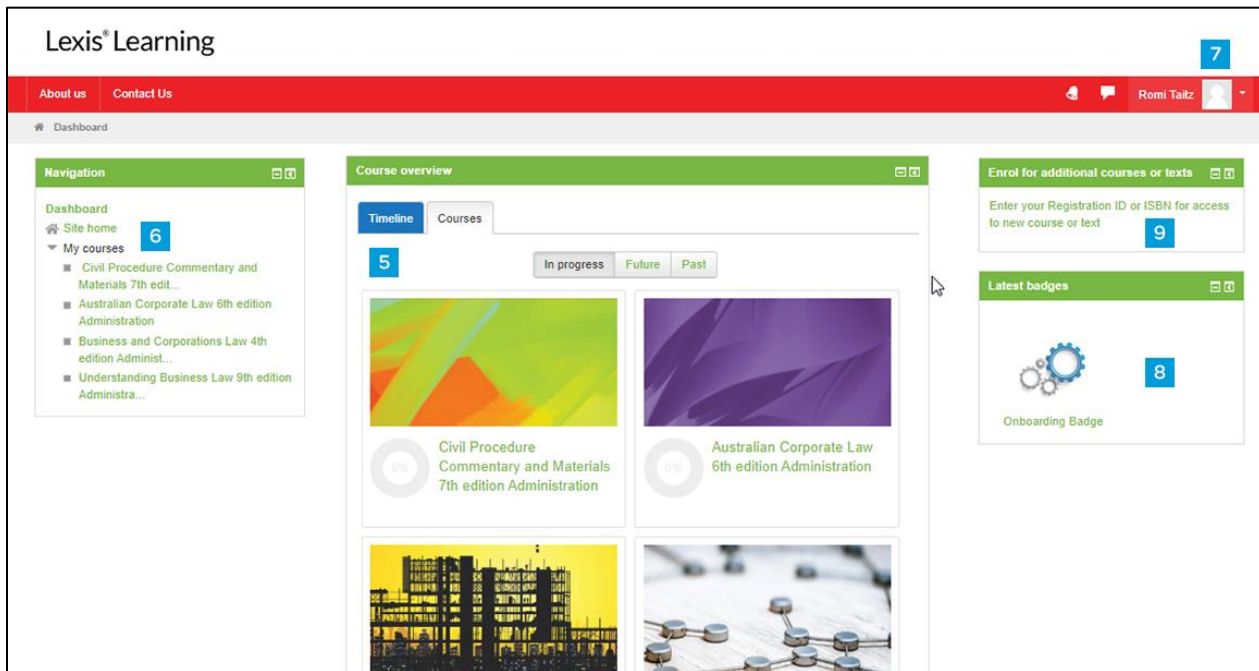

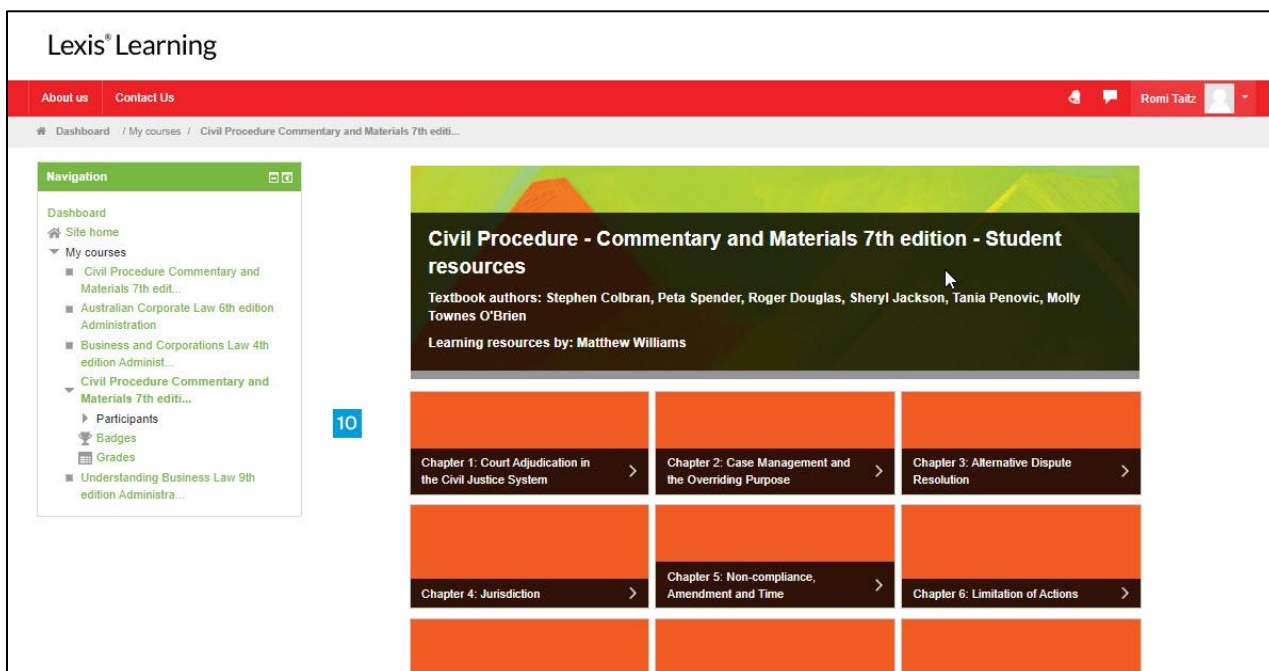

Clicking the link in the email will log you into Lexis® Learning. Once you have logged in, you will land on your dashboard. This provides a quick view of the text course pages you have been enrolled onto along with your course progress [5]. Courses can also be selected from 'My Courses' in the left-hand side navigation panel [6]. You can customize your profile in the top right-hand corner [7]. Any obtained badges will be presented on this page [8]. Should you wish to register for additional texts, use the 'Enrol for additional courses or texts' block on the right-hand side [9].



Clicking onto the title of the text will reveal the course page. Select the relevant chapter/section from which you would like to review resources from [10]



The list of available resources will be displayed [11]. If a course has been designed with activities with a score, these can be accessed via grades [12]. Easily navigate to chapters/sections across the top of the course page [13].
